Avian Influenza & Outbreak Update ***Most recent news . . .***

Restrictions on movement of birds in both Tennessee and Kentucky have been lifted. Facilities in both states that have been undergoing monitoring have continued to test negative and no new outbreaks have been detected.

It is important that members not allow comingling of pigeons and poultry. We also encourage members to follow recommended bio-security measures.

AU Bio-Security Recommendations

Basic bio-security measures should always be used. It is more important than ever to make sure you are cleaning your loft regularly, washing hands going in and out of the loft, monitoring or perhaps restricting others from going in and out of your loft and placing new birds in a quarantine section before integrating them with your other birds.
