

AU President's Cup – Young Birds 2010 & Old Birds 2011

The AU President's Cup is the ultimate loft award for superior performances in both old birds and young birds. A minimum of ten and a maximum of twelve qualifying races in which the competitor scores in the top 20% must be flown: five young bird races, four middle distance old bird races and one, two or three long distance old bird races, depending on local schedules.

This award is unique in that it showcases outstanding performance in both old bird and young bird racing, measuring a high level of loft performance. Final scores are achieved by combining a lofts Old Bird and Young Bird Champion Loft Scores.

The best scoring loft is awarded the AU President's Cup Award. The second best score receives the Runner Up AU President's Cup Award. The next eight qualified lofts are listed as Qualified Contenders in their order of finish.

The American Racing Pigeon Union is proud to recognize those who have excelled and achieved the AU President's Cup award for 2010 young birds and 2011 old birds.
