Avian Influenza & Outbreak Update **Most recent news . . .**

The Wisconsin State Veterinarian eliminated banning poultry movement on June 20. We have also received notice from the Minnesota Board of Animal Health advising that as of July 1, they have lifted their temporary poultry exhibition ban.

Members are encouraged to monitor their State Veterinarian and Department of Agriculture websites. This is where you will find any restrictions state officials may be imposing at this time in your state. ***Each State Veterinarian may implement the restrictions they feel are necessary to protect their poultry industry. Those restrictions vary from state to state and change frequently.***

AU Bio-Security Recommendations

Basic bio-security measures should always be used. It is more important than ever to make sure you are cleaning your loft regularly, washing hands going in and out of the loft, monitoring or perhaps restricting others from going in and out of your loft and placing new birds in a quarantine section before integrating them with your other birds.
