Avian Influenza & Outbreak Update Most recent news . . .

Avian Influenza (HPAI) has now been detected in both commercial and backyard flocks of poultry in 39 states across the U.S.

The USDA recently reported HPAI in a non-commercial backyard poultry flock in Obion County, Tennessee. The update is found at:

The USDA is recommending flocks be brought in when possible to protect them from wild birds. Alternatively, secure your lofts to prevent wild birds from gaining access to your birds.

AU Bio-Security Recommendations

Basic bio-security measures should always be used. It is more important than ever to make sure you are cleaning your loft regularly, washing hands going in and out of the loft, monitoring or perhaps restricting others from going in and out of your loft and placing new birds in a quarantine section before integrating them with your other birds.
