Virulent Newcastle disease (vND) was detected in a small flock of backyard exhibition chickens in Los Angeles County on May 16, 2018, by the California Animal Health and Food Safety Laboratory System (CAHFS). Testing was confirmed by the USDA APHIS on May 17, 2018.

AU Bio-Security Recommendations

Basic bio-security measures should always be used. It is more important than ever to make sure you are cleaning your loft regularly, washing hands going in and out of the loft, monitoring or perhaps restricting others from going in and out of your loft and placing new birds in a quarantine section before integrating them with your other birds.
